



FIRST LESSON Habakkuk 1:1-6, 9-11 Pew Bible, pg. 762 The oracle that the prophet Habakkuk saw. O Lord, how long shall I cry for help, and you will not listen? 
WORDS OF ASSURANCE Habakkuk 2:2-4; 3:17-19a
